



**REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR FAMILY REUNION VISA FOR DEPENDENT PARENTS**  
**MANDATORY DOCUMENTS (FOR ALL APPLICANTS): Please show original documents at the time of**  
**Submission of Application for Verification**

1.	Application form fully completed and signed by the applicant		
2.	Two recent passport-size photographs (white background). Please do not staple the photographs to the application form.		
3.	Passport/Travel Document must: a) Have been issued within the previous 10 years and the validity must not exceed 10 yrs b) At least have a validity of 3 months after intended stay. c) Have 2 Blank Pages		
4.	“Nulla Osta” (No Objection Certificate) in original, issued by competent Questura in Italy. Kindly note that the “Nulla Osta” is valid only for a period up to six months from date of issue. The “Nulla Osta” will have to be renewed on expiry.		
5.	Discrepancy, if any, in the names of the applicant/s on the “Nulla Osta” and the passport/s, should be corrected to correspond with the name on the passport.		
6.	Photocopy of the passport (all pages) of the person who has applied for the “Nulla Osta” in Italy. If available, also of the old passport.		
7.	Photocopy of the “Permesso di soggiorno” (Permit of stay).		
8.	Photocopy of the air ticket (only after having received the visa)		
9.	Verification of original documents and of the English translation of Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificates, Ration Cards & other relevant documentation. * If any change has occurred in this regard an adequate proof of residence needs to be submitted (Bank account, telephone/electricity bill etc.)		
10.	Original Birth Certificate of the son/daughter residing in Italy, issued by the Registrar of Births and Deaths, clearly mentioning the registration number, along with translation in English language, both duly attested by the Under Secretary, Home Department.		
11.	Affidavit from parents stating the name of all the children (even if not living together), their date of birth and current residential address in India or abroad.		
12.	A parent is considered dependent on the son/daughter in Italy when he/she does not receive any income in India and does not have other children in India. Even if he/she receives minimum pension, he/she must provide proof of having received some remittance of money for a reasonable period of time from the family member in Italy. Kindly provide original bank account passbook of the applicant/s and remittance certificates from Italy (mandatory) and India. Official documents should also be submitted in case the parent/s own property in India and are receiving any income thereof.		

**PLEASE NOTE:** All documents must be submitted in original. Documents such as Birth & Marriage Certificates, School Leaving Certificates must be submitted in original and photocopy. Photocopies to be done ONLY after attestation by the Under Secretary, Home Department. The above mentioned originals (Birth & Marriage Certificates and School Leaving Certificate) will be RETURNED after the visa processing.

The Embassy/Consulate reserves the right to request for further documentation and to verify the documentation submitted. In this case the maximum period of 90 days fixed by the Italian law for the evaluation of this visa type will be suspended till verification is completed.
