



**REQUISITE DOCUMENTS FOR FAMILY REUNION VISA FOR JOINING SPOUSE  
RESIDENT IN ITALY**

**MANDATORY DOCUMENTS (FOR ALL APPLICANTS): Please show original documents at the time of Submission of Application for Verification**

	Application form fully completed and signed by the applicant		
	Two recent passport-size photographs (white background). Please do not staple the photographs to the application form.		
	Passport having validity of 90 days from date of expiry of visa with 1 blank page, issued within the jurisdiction of the Embassy/Consulate *		
	“Nulla Osta” (No Objection Certificate) in original, issued by competent Questura in Italy. Kindly note that the “Nulla Osta” is valid only for a period up to six months from date of issue. The “Nulla Osta” will have to be renewed on expiry.		
	Discrepancy, if any, in the names of the applicant/s on the “Nulla Osta” and the passport/s, should be corrected to correspond with the name on the passport.		
	Photocopy of the passport (all pages) of the person who has applied for the “Nulla Osta” in Italy. If available, also of the old passport.		
	Photocopy of the “Permesso di soggiorno” (Permit of stay).		
	Photocopy of the air ticket (only after having received the visa)		
	Verification of original documents and of the English translation of Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificates, Ration Cards & other relevant documentation. * If any change has occurred in this regard an adequate proof of residence needs to be submitted (Bank account, telephone/electricity bill etc.)		
	The spouse residing in Italy may produce his/her certificate in Italy and have it attested by the local Italian Authorities (Comune).		
	Marriage Certificate in original along with translation in English both attested by the local Authorities and verified by the Under Secretary, Home Department.		
	Photocopy of the passport of the spouse in Italy, clearly showing the dates of arrival/departure in India for the celebration of the marriage and the registration of the same.		

**PLEASE NOTE:** All documents must be submitted in original. Documents such as Birth & Marriage Certificates, School Leaving Certificates must be submitted in original and photocopy. Photocopies to be done ONLY after attestation by the Under Secretary, Home Department. The above mentioned originals (Birth & Marriage Certificates and School Leaving Certificates) will be RETURNED after the visa processing.

The Embassy/Consulate reserves the right to request for further documentation and to verify the documentation submitted. In this case the maximum period of 90 days fixed by the Italian law for the evaluation of this visa type will be suspended till verification is completed.
